### HOW are STUDENTS SUPPORTED THROUGH SWS?

- 7-8 students
  - 1 block of pull-out services for two full marking periods (if receiving ELA or Math)
  - 1 block of pull-out services for one full year (if receiving ELA and Math)
  - Pull-out course is in addition to scheduled ELA and/or Math class
- K-8 supports:
  - Mini-lessons on key foundational skills
  - Pre-teaching concepts
  - Re-teaching concepts
